TERMS AND CONDITIONS (BP-0002) to provide conditions to allow for Shabbat Services indoors.

We are all challenged by COVID-19. We are all in this together and we need your help to ensure we can return to services in a safe manner. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this transitional phased re-opening period for TBS-EV.

The following are the requirements to be followed for those attending services.

During this time of elevated case numbers, strict adherence to the guidelines are absolutely mandatory to manage risk of infection with COVID 19. People who are at risk according to CDC guidelines, or are uncomfortable attending gatherings should consult a physician to make a decision on attendance.

PLEASE READ ALL OF THE INFORMATION BELOW and acknowledge for all people you are registering. These requirements are being updated by the board periodically so the only way to ensure you understand the current requirements is to read through them each time you register.

I acknowledge that:

-All attending are fully vaccinated (2 weeks after J&J dose or 2 weeks after 2nd dose of Pfizer or Moderna) for all over the CDC/FDA approved age. This will be verified the first time when showing up for attendance and will be tracked going forward. (I understand that I must show proof of vaccination at the door or send it in advance to the link below.) Those who cannot provide proof at the door or have not been verified in advance will not be permitted to enter the sanctuary.

-All under 18 (without vaccine) with vaccinated parent/ guardian present. Under 18 must stay with their family unit.

-Each household **MUST** sit such that there are at least two seats (12 foot spacing) and two rows between them and the next nearest households.

-I understand that I **MUST** maintain a minimum of 6 ft. distancing from all non-household members at all times and 12 ft. minimum distancing for events involving projected voices (I will maintain this proper distance from anyone outside of those submitted on my registration, regardless of vaccination status).

-I understand that the capacity in the Sanctuary is currently limited to only 50 people including Bar/Bat Mitzvah and by submitting this form I have full intention to attend as selected on the form below.

-I do not have a fever. I feel healthy, and I have had no flu-like symptoms or other symptoms consistent with COVID-19 infection for at least seven days.

-I have not had any loss of the senses of smell or taste in the past seven days.

-I do not have shortness of breath, cough, runny nose, congestion, or other respiratory symptoms and haven't in the past seven days.

-I have not had close or sustained contact with anyone with the above symptoms in the past 14 days.

-I understand that I MUST wear a mask that fully covers my mouth and nose. A clear plastic face shield alone is insufficient.

-I understand that no food or drink will be provided by Temple Beth Shalom.

-I understand that if I do not follow the practices listed above that I will be asked to leave the premises immediately without question.

Please be respectful to other congregants during this period of re-entry to our sanctuary. If you can not make it to the event or would like to be removed, PLEASE use the "CONTACT THE ORGANIZER" button to free up the space for someone else.
